- Structured abstracts are mandatory.
- Incomplete submissions of abstracts will not be considered.
- It is the author's responsibility to submit a correct abstract; any errors in spelling, grammar, or scientific fact may be reproduced as typed by the author, if accepted.
- The allocated poster boards space is cm 150 height and cm 90 base.
- Poster material must be prepared in advance and should be large enough to be viewed at a distance of 2m.
- Drawing and charts should be clear and simple.
- Acknowledgement of receipt of the submission will be sent to the stated e-mail address under section «Personal details».
- Changes to abstracts can only be accepted until the deadline (**10 September**) using your Personal Page.
- Notification on acceptance of the abstracts will be e-mailed by (**11 October**).
- The corresponding authors will receive all correspondence concerning the abstracts and is responsible for informing the other authors of the status of the abstract.
- Conflict of Interest/Disclosure:
Work submitted for presentation must include an acknowledgement of funding sources of commercial nature and/or consulting of holding of significant equity in a company that could be affected by the results of the study.
- All studies must have been approved by institutional committees on ethics of experimental and human investigations.
- Specific time allocation will be given during lunchtime/coffee breaks. During this time, posters should be attended by the authors for viewing and discussion.
- Abstracts will be published in a supplement of the International Journal of Psychiatry in Clinical Practice.

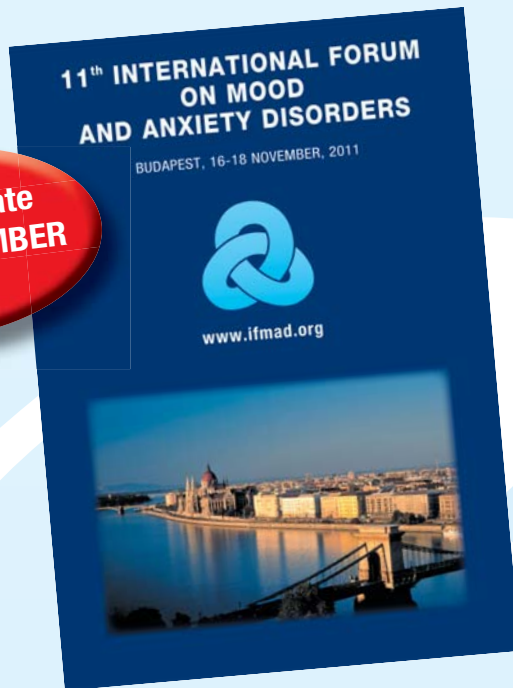

Dosage: Usual dose is 10 mg daily. Maximum dose 20 mg daily. In elderly (>65 years), in panic disorder patients and in patients with reduced hepatic function an initial dose of 5 mg daily is recommended. Caution in patients with severely reduced renal function. Not recommended in children

and adolescents (<18 years). When stopping treatment the dose should be gradually reduced over a period of one or two weeks.
Contraindications: Hypersensitivity to escitalopram. Concomitant treatment with MAOIs.
Pregnancy and lactation: Careful consideration prior to use in pregnant women. Breast-feeding women should not be treated.
Precautions: The special warnings and precautions which apply to the class of SSRIs.
Drug interactions: MAOIs, serotonergic drugs, drugs lowering the seizure threshold, lithium

tryptophan, St. John's Wort, anticoagulants, drugs metabolised mainly by enzymes CYP 2D6 or 2C19.
Adverse events: Most frequent during the first or second week, very common is nausea, less frequent is adverse events comprising to the SSRI class.
Overdosage: Doses between 400 mg and 800 mg of escitalopram alone have been taken without any severe symptoms. Consult full prescribing information before prescribing. H. Lundbeck A/S, Copenhagen, Denmark.
